




Fitler Nine Townhouses

Located in the Fitler Square area of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Fitler Nine is a set of nine luxurious four-story townhomes. The townhomes vary between 5,000 square feet and 5,800 square feet, and feature a number of amenities for its residents. Architects QB3 worked with us through our Design Assist program to find the perfect porcelain panels for this ventilated façade project. They looked through our stone series of porcelain and wanted to create a livelier façade design by using a warmer toned product.


They decided to move forward with using 10,000 square feet of our Boston Bone and Boston Topo porcelain panels. The lighter Boston Bone shade was used as a base, and the Boston Topo tone was used intermittently throughout the design as an accent.







The Nevins

Brooklyn, NY

The Nevins is a modern high-rise residential building that is located in the trendy Boerum Hill area of Brooklyn, New York. It is close to the Fort Greene Park, the Brooklyn Academy of Music, and the Brooklyn Bridge.

The 21 story building houses 73 different residences that range from studios to 3 bedroom units that take up entire floors.

Issac & Stern Architects worked with Porcelanosa to find the perfect texture and color for their façade design. The Nevins is completely covered in 21,000 square feet of Porcelanosa's concrete-look Dover Arena porcelain panels, which were cut down to 12 3/8" x 47" panels specifically for the project.





The building offers modernly designed two-story suites, a rooftop deck, a private gym, and units filled with natural light due to their floor-to-ceiling windows and balconies.



The Alexey

Brooklyn, NY

The Alexey is a newly built, high-rise residential building located in the southern area of Park Slope area of Brooklyn, New York. It is right off of both the Gowanus Expressway and the Prospect Expressway, and isn't far from Prospect Park, Grand Army Plaza, or Industry City.

The building features 92 modernly designed units throughout its 12 floors, and is located near a number of restaurants, bars, and more.

The Alexey features an eye-catching staggered appearance, with parts of the building recessing and appearing as if they are floating out of it. The building uses a combination of Ferroker Caldera and Tribeca Caliza porcelain panels throughout the design of the façade.

The building is covered in the light stone look Tribeca Caliza panels, while the dark metallic-look Ferroker Caldera panels are used as accents along the window panes in addition to smaller, protruding segments of the façade – making a total of 13,000 square feet of porcelain cladding material used throughout the façade's design.

15 East 19 Street

Brooklyn, NY

15 East 19th Street is a new residential building located in the Flatbush area of Brooklyn, New York.

The building is close to the southern area of Prospect Park, and towers over a rare cul-de-sac in the middle of Brooklyn. Its 8 story structure houses 33 oversized 1 and 2 bedroom sapartment units.

The light grey façade of 15 East 19th Street is comprised of 2 different large format sizes of Boston Topo that are laid horizontally across the building in a staggered pattern. Architects RoART created this as a subtle nod to imitate the vintage brickwork on the older Victorian houses that used to inhabit the area.


The building is covered in over 3,500 square feet of porcelain panels, and is accented by floor-to-ceiling windows and glass encased balconies. It has a sleek and modern look, which is also reflected on the units within it.







The stunning 225 West 17th Street building is located on the southern end of Chelsea in Manhattan, NY, and is in close proximity to the High Line, Chelsea Piers, and Chelsea Market.

This building, created by Rogers Partners, features over 4,000 square feet of Porcelanosa's On Black porcelain panels in its ventilated façade design. The building's structure has been in existence since 1912 and has been transformed from its old manufacturing facility to a luxurious residential building with 14 residences that span across 10 floors.


The On Black porcelain panels appear on the building in a staggered pattern and are accented by metal trims. Its rich, dark color also helps 225 West 17th Street stand out on the street amongst the neighboring buildings that surround it.






ALTA LIC is a 44 story high-rise luxury building that has over 460 residentiald units within it. Located in Long Island City area of Queens, New York, this building has emerged as one of the tallest in the area. The building is located near multiple subway and train lines, and the overall ventilated façade design helps to soundproof the building from the bustling trains that pass by and overall noise outside.

Designed by Stephen B. Jacobs Group, ALTA LIC features Porcelanosa's textured and dimensional Cubica Black panels, which are primarily used near the ground levels and entrances of the building, while the bright Extreme White porcelain panels soar and extend up the unique ventilated façade design.

The Extreme White panels with their vertically staggered overview look emulate a modern interpretation of a classical Art-Deco styled silhouette, and are accented with a set of glass panels at the top of the building.



Dahlia is a newly constructed condominium building, located at 212 West 95th Street in the Upper West Side neighborhood of Manhattan, New York. The building is located near Central Park West and Riverside Park.

Created by RKTB Architects, Dahlia is a 20 story building with 38 two, three, and four bedroom residences within it. It also has many amenities for its guests, including a 5,100 square foot private elevated park within the building.

Inspired by the rare, blooming flower that it is named after, Dahlia is covered in over 15,000 square feet of custom made porcelain panels, and is accented by contrasting vertical black window frames.


The porcelain panels have a neutral beige color and were cut down into various sizes. The porcelain panels were laid in a horizontally staggered pattern over the building.





Hudson 36 is a newly constructed high-rise building on 36th Street in Manhattan, New York. It is a 39 story multifamily building that has over 250 rental units, retail space, and more – all with stunning views of the Hudson River.

The building is located in the up and coming Hudson Yards area, and is within walking distance of the Vessel, the High Line, many shops and restaurants in Hudson Yards, Penn Station, and the Javits Center.

The building's façade features over 50,000 square feet of Porcelanosa's Ark White Bright large format porcelain panels, which features a custom developed color that was created with Ismael Leyva Architects for this project.

The protruding bright, white facade accents many windows, glass panels, and metal louvres, and truly stands out amongst its urban surroundings.






3200 Washington is a luxury condominium building, located in Boston's trendy Jamaica Plain neighborhood.

This 6-story mid-rise building features 76 residential units, a restaurant, and retail spaces. Some of the resident amenities include a community rooftop terrace, a large courtyard, and more

3200 Washington's exterior is covered with over 8,200 square feet of porcelain cladding material. The building's contemporary design is anchored by the stone-look of Porcelanosa's Max Grey Lappato and Max Grey Nature large format porcelain panels.

The cool grey porcelain panels are accented by black panels. The building's cool-toned exterior is contrasted by its bright interior and accents in vibrant colors such as magenta staircases and lime green and aqua blue accent furniture.





Located at 321 Wythe Ave. in the Williamsburg area of Brooklyn, New York, this luxurious building features 24,000 square feet of Porcelanosa's Ferroker Titanio panels on its façade design. This high-rise building can be seen from the East River and the Williamsburg Bridge, and is close to Domino Park.

The bright Ferroker Niquel panels run vertically across the building, and are accented by black outlined windows and panels. Up-close, the Ferroker Niquel panels have a unique industrial and metallic finish.

The building contains 130 rental units throughout its 19 stories, and offers more than 20,000 square feet of both indoor and outdoor amenities.





Prime LIC is a newly built condominium building located in the Long Island City neighborhood of Queens, New York. The building's residents can witness stunning views of the Empire State Building, the Queensboro and Williamsburg Bridges, and more.



It is 11 stories high, consists of over 60,000 square feet of residential space, and has the popular grocery store chain Trader Joe's located within the building's ground retail space.


Prime LIC features a minimalistic appearance with neutral tones that are used throughout both the interior and exterior space of the building. Its envelope is wrapped with over 27,000 square feet of Aged Dark porcelain panels, and is accented by floor to ceiling windows and light grey panels.








The Clare

Manhattan, NY

The Clare is a majestic building that is located in the heart of the Upper East Side in Manhattan, New York. Located at 301 East 61st Street, the Clare has 19 stories and 30 residential units.

The condominium's design focuses on the use of natural light in every space, and its exterior features a bright beige color.

Unique to this project, Porcelanosa was able to develop custom porcelain panels that emulated the same look as the natural limestone that was used throughout the base of the building.

After completing the project, the architect Manuel Glas stated, "the open joint ventilated system, ease of installation, and durability of porcelain... inspired new ways to treat the facade."

Other Porcelanosa tile and bath products are featured throughout the walls, floors, bathrooms, and balconies of the units within the building.



The Leyton

Manhattan, NY

Located in the Lenox Hill neighborhood in the Upper East Side of Manhattan, New York, The Leyton is a slender building that soars 30 stories. The building's design, created by Manuel Glas Architects, is a modern interpretation of the Art Deco styles present in the neighboring landmark buildings of Rockefeller Center and The News Building.

The Leyton is covered in over 70,000 sq. ft. of Duna Grey Nature porcelain slabs, which are accented by floor-to-ceiling glass windows and balconies for the building's residents.

The building contains 38 residential units within it that have open floor layouts - all which can view Central Park, The Hudson River, and the surrounding cityscape that spans outside of it.

Other Porcelanosa tile products are also featured inside of the units – including XTONE Aged Dark Nature porcelain slab walls in the powder rooms, and Belice Acero and Dover Caliza within the secondary bathrooms.





Manhattan, NY

Convivium is a luxury apartment complex located at 515 East 86th Street in the Upper East Side area of Manhattan, New York. It is a massive 22 story building with 140 apartments that vary between studio, one, two and three bedroom units, and over 45% of the units have outdoor balconies and terraces. It is near the East River and within walking distance of Carl Schurz Park.

The building is covered in 2 different types of porcelain panels (one with a light grey hue, and the other with a dark grey), which were both custom designed for the project. The building is covered in over 18,000 square feet of porcelain panels. Many of the bathrooms within units also feature custom designed Porcelanosa sinks, full bathtub and shower installations, and large vanity units.







Tangram House South is located in the Flushing neighborhood of Queens, New York. It has 192 units throughout its 12 stories, along with many amenities for its residents – including a landscaped rooftop garden, a fitness center, and more. Tangram House South is part of the new and unique Tangram development – which features 2 massive residential towers, a Renaissance Hotel, a retail area, a movie theater, business offices, and a garden. It is close to Citi Flied, the Queens Botanical Garden, and the Queens Zoo.

The Tangram House South building has a façade with a unique monochromatic look that is made up of 3 different porcelain panel designs – metallic Ferroker Niquel, bright Extreme White, and Deep Light Grey. The porcelain façade blends in with the existing brick building base and is accented with many glass windows and balconies.


